"Shorelines of Norfolk Island" Definitive Part 1

Issue date 30th September, 2013

Norfolk's beautiful shorelines are the feature of our next Definitive Stamp Issue parts 1 & 2. Each part will consist of 6 stamps.

Shorelines of Norfolk Island

.15c Ball Bay – So named after Lieutenant Lidgbird Ball, commander of the armed tender "Supply", is where the local surfers say the "best surf on Norfolk Island is". This is also the bay where the tankers come into to discharge their fuel and gas into holding tanks for the island's use.

.60c Second Sands – a beautiful little beach that boasts a lovely little pool, popular with some islanders for a day in the sun, rock fishing. It is from here you can get a great view of Kingston. It is a bit of walk across the stones, from Bumboras, hence its name Seconds Sands, but we love it there.

.95c Slaughter Bay, is thought to get its name from the old English word which means slow moving water, Slaughter Bay, has a reef that you can step onto at low tide, it is a great beach for snorkelling and the fish will come up and eat out of your hands if you wish to feed them.

\$1.20 Anson Bay – another popular beach for swimmers and surfers, there are strong undercurrents at this beach, and this rock is known as Pulpit rock for obvious reasons.

\$1.70 Bumboras – although rocky with quite a bit of reef area, this is another popular beach amongst the islanders, kids love it when it is high tide as there is a rock pool with a good sized rock for jumping off and catching the waves into shore. Because the rocks are basalt, they get nice and warm during the day and the littlies love to lay on them and warm up when they get too cold from swimming.

\$1.85 Emily Bay – this beautiful beach is a very popular family beach, it's calm waters at low tide, make it a relatively safe beach for all ages, and the raft is really popular for all ages. Lots of barbecues, birthdays and weddings are held in this area throughout the year.


